## Village Projects

### **Records Management Grant**

The Village Clerk-Treasurer and the WCP Consultants will be submitting a grant through the New York State Archives for the Records Management Grant.

### **Wastewater Facility**

The Village wastewater facility has been an ongoing project. As of March 2024, we have not received any of the grants that we applied for in 2023. The Village engineers and Mayor Boucher have sent letters to local/state representatives for help gathering funding. This project is estimated to cost 9 million dollars and the Village is in desperate need of a new wastewater treatment facility due to the current facility being built in the 1970s.

### **Noble Street Bridge**

Jefferson County will be re-doing the bridge on Noble Street. This project is estimated to go out to bid by April 2024. The Village may need to turn off water to residents for a short time during this project due to the County moving the underground utilities. We will notify residents affected as soon as we have more information.
