The Regulation and Control of Dogs

The purpose of this law shall be to preserve the public peace, health and order in the Village of Evans Mills and to contribute to the public welfare, and preservation of the person and property of the inhabitants thereof by Declaring and enforcing regulations and restrictions on the activities of dogs and their owners within the Village limits.

No owner of any dog shall suffer, permit or allow such dog to commit any public nuisance within the Village of Evans Mills or cause damage to the person or property of others.

The following acts are hereby declared to be public nuisances:

- Howling and barking in such a way as to reasonably disturb and annoy other persons.
- Jumping upon any person or knocking any person over.
- Biting, snapping or growling at any person, or other animal.
- Fighting with or attacking any other dog or animal.
- Permitting any dog to be at large anywhere within the Village of Evans Mills other than on the premises of said person. The owner, keeper, harbinger or person having custody and control of a dog in the Village of Evans Mills shall control and restrain such dog and shall be of such physical ability so as to be able to control and restrain same by an adequate collar and leash, not exceeding six (6) feet in length, except when the dog is on the premises of said person.
- Permitting or allowing any dog to urinate, defecate or to commit any other nuisance in any park, public place or on any private property other than that of said person, except that a dog being walked on a leash shall be curbed and any feces deposited by the dog shall be cleaned up immediately by the owner, keeper, harbinger, or person having control of the dog. To curb a dog shall mean that the dog shall not be allowed to urinate or defecate except along the edge of the road.
- Tampering with or foraging at garbage pails or trash containers, or littering any area with refuse.

- Reminder, that the Village of Evans Mills has an overnight parking law. The Village law states that **no vehicle shall be parked on any street within the Village of Evans Mills between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day from November 1 through March 31.** The purpose of this law is to enable the Village Department of Public Works to clear the streets of snow and ice. Vehicles violating this law will be towed at the owner's expense. Thank You!
- **Winter Sidewalk Care:** Please be aware that according to Article I, Section 5 of Local Law #4 of 2023, sidewalks are to be maintained by the property owner. Sidewalks are to be cleared of snow no later than 72 hours after a snowfall. If your sidewalk is not cleared, the Village will remove the snow and you will be charged **\$75.00 for the first offense and \$150.00** for subsequent offenses. This rule is in effect to ensure the safety of all of our pedestrians. Your cooperation is appreciated!

Inside Users:

Water - \$50.00 (First 8,000 Gallons)
.00375 per gallon over 8,000 gallons
Sewer - \$85.00 Per Unit/Quarter
Water Debt - 0.0025 Per Gallon of Usage



Outside Users:

Water - \$90.00 (First 8,000 Gallons)
.00750 per gallon over 8,000 gallons
Sewer - \$160.00 Per Unit/Quarter
Water Debt - 0.0025 Per Gallon of Usage
