Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2023

A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 3-C OF THE NEW YORK GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW

On the motion of Trustee Greg Smith and seconded by Trustee Teresa Fleming, the following local law is put forward:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Village of Evans Mills (the "Village") through this local law to allow the Village to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2023, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by New York General Municipal Law § 3-C.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted by the Board pursuant to General Municipal Law § 3-C, Subdivision 5, which expressly authorizes a local government to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of not less than 60% of the governing body of such local government.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

This local law overrides the tax levy limit provided in General Municipal Law § 3-C. The Board is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year for the Village commencing June 1, 2023, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed by General Municipal Law § 3-C.

Section 4. Severability

If a Court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm, corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the Court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall have been rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

This local law was declared duly adopted by not less than 60% of the Board.


