We have been working with P&T supply on the changing out our aging pumps at the water plant with new energy-efficient ones. We are also in the process of changing out our water meter transmitters with new improved ones making ours and the clerks' duties much more efficient. We will also continue working with our engineer on the new sewer plant upgrade as our existing 1970 plant has run its course and it is time for a new one; to keep up with new State-mandated testing and treatment guidelines that go into effect in 2021. We have provided you with a look at the cost to other local municipalities that have had to incur; due to similar situations. We plan to make water and sewer rate increases yearly to help ease into the change.

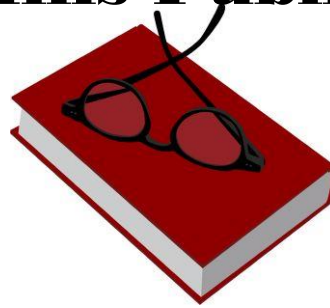
