WATER & SEWER INCREASES

Starting June 1st, 2021, the following utility increases will take place.

WATER: \$40/UNIT (first 8,000 gallons)

SEWER: \$75/UNIT

H2O DEBT: NO INCREASE.

Lead & Copper Results- The 20 homes tested in the Village of Evans Mills Passed the second lead & copper draw on February 11th, 2021. The next testing will be in June of 2021.

If you do NOT have a softener installed please contact the Village DPW at **315.783.6584** to be signed up as a possible sample site.

*Softeners that are not properly maintained can create harsh water (lead & copper) in your home. When you install a softener in your home, you are altering the chemistry of the pretreated water provided by the Village of Evans Mills. Therefore you are subject to conduct the testing of your own water.

In June we will be handing out homeowner certification forms to 20 homes. It is extremely important that you read and follow the directions thoroughly. Please remember that Federal forms must be completed fully with signature and date. If you have questions about the test please do not hesitate to contact me at **315.783.6584**, I am more than willing to help guide you.
