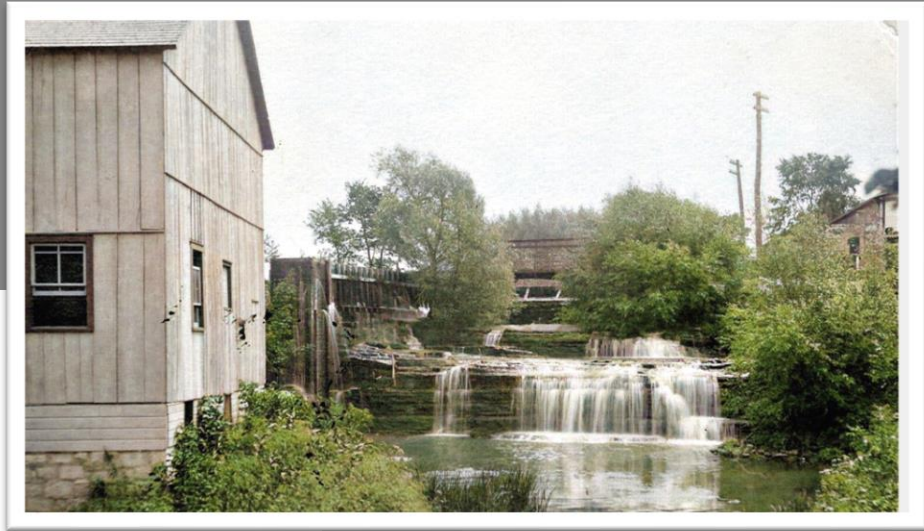

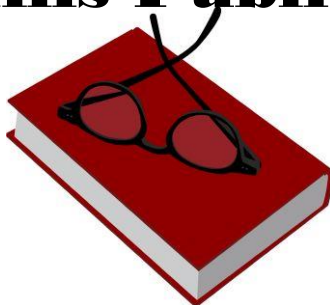
NOTICED THE NEW AROMA IN THE MILLS LATELY?

Evans Mills Public Library



1. First and foremost, the Evans Mills Public Library Board and all library staff members hope everyone is staying healthy and safe!

At this time, we're pleased to announce that we will be starting a Curb Side Service at the Evans Mills Public Library on **Monday, July 6!** Curb Side hours will be Monday and Tuesday 1-5 and Wednesday 3-7.

All orders must be placed in advance. To order please call us at 315-629-4483 or reserve your holds through the catalog at catalog.ncls.org beginning **June 10.** We will notify you when your holds are ready. Please schedule a time during our curbside hours to pick up items ordered. If other pick up arrangements are needed, please notify the staff and we will be happy to make any necessary accommodations.

Upon arrival at the library and call us at 315-629-4483 to let us know you are here. A staff member will place your items on the step outside the front door and you may retrieve them after the staff member has re-entered the building.

Return items should be placed in our cardboard box on the step near the front door of the library. Materials are quarantined for 72 hours. After the quarantine period the book covers, CD and DVD cases, and CD's and DVD's are cleansed with disinfectant, discharged, and returned to the shelf. When a patron requests library material, it is pulled from the shelves, cleansed with a disinfectant, and bagged for the checkout. Our cleaning procedures follow directives from the CDC.

Thank you all for your patience and understanding during this process as it is a learning curve of all parties involved. The safety of our community, patrons, and staff is a priority above all else.
